About MnP26

Global plastic pollution is on the rise, with micro- and nanoplastic particles and plastic-associated chemicals posing threats to the environment and human health. We require detailed understanding of the sources of plastic and of the fate and transport mechanisms of micro- and nanoplastic that determine environmental and human exposures and uptake.

This international event will for the first time bring together interdisciplinary researchers, public and private sector practitioners from environmental, health, social, behavioural and political backgrounds to catalyse discussions of the interconnected plastic challenges in a **One Health** context.

The five-day event will feature keynote talks, interactive panels, and research showcases designed to spark meaningful dialogue and innovative approaches. With a strong focus on cross-disciplinary collaboration, the conference welcomes academics, policymakers, students, and industry professionals alike.

- Interdisciplinary **One Health** approaches
- Ecotoxicological and toxicological studies revealing the human and environmental health risks


